Sec. 106-804. Visibility triangles.

It shall be unlawful for any person to plant or maintain any plant or ground cover within a visibility triangle, if the plant has a height greater than three feet above the street gutter flow line. It shall be unlawful for any person to plant or maintain a tree, which has branches or foliage within or above a visibility triangle at a height lower than fifteen feet above the street gutter flow line. The city may enter a visibility triangle and remove growths prohibited by this section.
