

Sec. 90-4. - Obstruction of visibility at intersection.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any owner of property on a street intersection corner in the city to permit a fence, vine, tree, shrub, structure or any other opaque object to remain on the property, which is within six lineal feet of the legal street corner and which prevents a driver of a vehicle from having a clear view through the six-foot area of the intersecting street in the opposing direction. Excluded, however, are neatly trimmed trees, utility poles and supporting fence posts.
- (b) Any person who violates this section shall be punished, upon conviction, pursuant to section 1-14.
